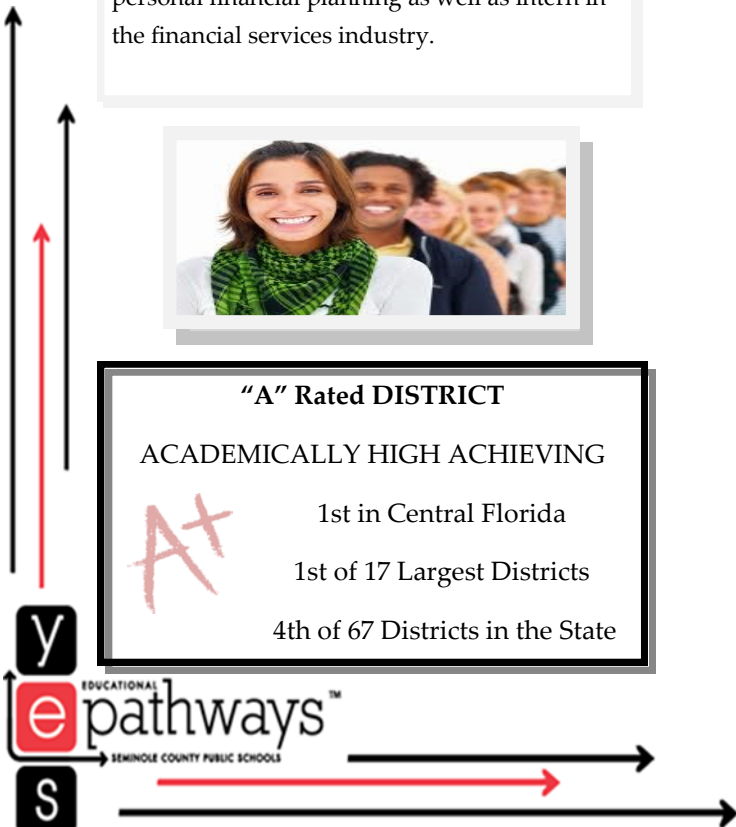
Seminole County Public Schools recognizes today's students learn in different ways, at different rates, and on different schedules.
