- Academics
- Gifted level/ AP offerings all four years
 - AP Human Geography- open to Freshmen-course code 2103400C
 - AP Biology -open to Freshmen
 - Sophomore year and beyond- extensive AP offerings across academic subjects and electives

Important Codes:

When signing up for classes, look for these codes which will signal if you will be in the correct course

An **L** at the end of a course code means that it is a **GIFTED** section. Students must be staffed Gifted to be placed in the course.

A **C** at the end of a code indicates **CAPSTONE**. Capstone is a special diploma, project based course that is linked with Seminar and Research in Junior and Senior Year. .

Additional Programs of Interest

- AP Capstone- interdisciplinary
 - Leads to an AP Capstone Diploma
 - Project-based, research, writing, presentation skills
 - Team work, project management
 - Individual time management
 - High levels of student choice of study for group and independent projects
- Academy of Finance
- Languages- AP Spanish, French, German, Latin
- Arts- Band, Theater, Chorus, Drama

Capstone Interest Sample Pathway

- Freshman year: English I Gifted/ Honors
 - AP Human Geography

- Sophomore year: English II Gifted/ Honors
 - AP Psychology

- Junior Year: AP Language and Composition (College credit/ ENC 1101-1102) + AP Capstone Seminar

- Senior Year: AP Literature and Composition (College Credit) + AP Research

Gifted Educational Plan

- Spring 2021: student, teacher, parent input on student needs for the Educational Plan

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- August 2021: EP meeting and signing- phone or face-to-face- once for high school to set Gifted educational goals and address special concerns

Gifted Educational Plan

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- August 2021: EP meeting and signing- phone or face-to-face- once for high school to set Gifted educational goals and address special concerns
- Student must maintain at least one Gifted level academic class throughout high school to remain in the Educational Plan.
